Mr. Whiteside opened the Council meeting with a Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00 PM in the Horsham Township Library, 435 Babylon Road, Horsham, PA.

Mr. Whiteside asked for questions or comments from the public. Mr. Bill Dull, Tennis Ave., inquired as to the price of the branding project. Mr. Walker responded \$65,000.00 which included travel expense. Ms. Sarah Righter, 1300 Biwood Lane, asked that call posts be considered along the Powerline Trail.

Council recognized the 150th Anniversary of the Benjamin Obdyke company in Horsham. Mr. Walker reported that Benjamin Obdyke, a family business, has been in Horsham for over 20 years. Mr. David Campbell, President and CEO, was present to receive a recognition plaque from Council.

Mr. Whiteside asked for the will of Council concerning the List of Checks. It was moved by Mr. Gallagher second by Ms. Hill-Milbourne to approve the List of Checks in all funds in the amount of \$ 238,627.08 and further move to authorize payment of same.

Council reviewed the Zoning Hearing Board applications to be heard in August:

HTZHB 18-12: John Regula, 562 Coach Road: Council will be opposed to this application but would be neutral if it was attached to the existing house as per the original application

HTZHB 18-13: Larry & Robin Burkert, 600 Colonial Drive: Council will be neutral to this application with conditions

HTZHB 18-15: Douglas & Michelle Travis, 438 Summit Avenue: Council will be neutral to this application

HTZHB 18-16: Terri Oliver-Crabbe, 131 Bender Road: Council will be opposed to this application but would be neutral if there was a declaration of covenants to restrict it to an in-law suite/family member only

Mr. Whiteside asked for the will of Council concerning The Manors at Tennis Avenue. It was moved by Ms. Hill-Milbourne, second by Mr. Gallagher to adopt the Resolution as proposed granting preliminary/final approval to the Manors at Tennis Avenue, 989 Limekiln Pike land development application (18-2-D).
