



Caption: Measure proposing amendments to the City Charter of North Bend

Question: Shall proposed amendments to the City Charter of North Bend be adopted?

Summary: The City Council proposes these amendments to the City Charter. Amending the Charter requires an affirmative vote of City voters. If approved, the amendments take effect July 1, 2026.

Approving this measure would adopt amendments to the City's Charter. The primary proposed amendments are the following:

- Extending the Mayor's term of office from two years to four years;
- Modernizing the title of city administrator to city manager, and updating the separation between the council and administration.
- Providing for council rules to be established by ordinance or resolution;
- Updating the process to fill council vacancies in limited circumstances.
- Updating the process of removing a city councilor by a vote of the City Council after a public hearing.

A complete copy of the proposed Charter amendments is available at City Hall and at www.northbendoregon.gov. A "yes" vote adopts the proposed amendments. A "no" vote keeps the current Charter unchanged.
