

RESOLUTION NO. 3384

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BEND, COOS COUNTY, OREGON, CALLING A MEASURE ELECTION TO SUBMIT TO THE ELECTORS A FIVE-YEAR LOCAL OPTION PROPERTY TAX LEVY FOR NORTH BEND MUNICIPAL POOL OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of North Bend, Coos County, Oregon (the "City"), has determined that a need exists to fund the operations and maintenance of the North Bend Municipal Pool; and

WHEREAS, City voters approved a five-year local option property tax levy for pool operations and maintenance in 2021 under Measure 6-191, and that levy expired June 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City proposes a new five-year local option property tax levy at a rate not to exceed \$0.56 per \$1,000 of assessed value, beginning July 1, 2027, and ending June 30, 2032; and

WHEREAS, levy proceeds would be dedicated solely to pool operations, including staffing, utilities, equipment maintenance, and program costs, and could not be used for other City purposes or capital improvements; and

WHEREAS, the estimated total outlay for North Bend Municipal Pool operations and maintenance during the five-year levy period is \$3,290,000; and

WHEREAS, the proposed rate is estimated to raise \$440,300 in 2027-2028, \$470,100 in 2028-2029, \$483,800 in 2029-2030, \$497,800 in 2030-2031, and \$512,200 in 2031-2032, for an estimated total of \$2,404,200; and

WHEREAS, for property assessed at \$200,000, the estimated annual tax would be approximately \$112; and

WHEREAS, if the measure is not approved, the pool would not have a dedicated property-tax funding source, which could result in reduced hours, reduced programming, or closure; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to submit the proposed local option levy to the electors of the City at the November 3, 2026 election.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of North Bend, Coos County, Oregon, that:

- A. A measure election is hereby called for November 3, 2026, for the purpose of submitting to the electors of the City the question whether the City shall impose a five-year local option property tax levy at a rate not to exceed \$0.56 per \$1,000 of assessed value for North Bend Municipal Pool operations and maintenance, beginning in fiscal year 2027-2028.

City, a notice of receipt of the ballot title including notice that a dissatisfied registered voter may file a petition with the Circuit Court for review of the ballot title not later than the seventh business day after the ballot title is filed in substantially the form of Exhibit B.

- E. Pursuant to ORS 254.095, the City Elections official will deliver a Notice of City Measure Election in substantially the form of Exhibit A to the Coos County Elections Office.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted by the City Council of the City of North Bend, Coos County, Oregon, this 11th day of August, 2026.

Caption - 10 words or less

Five-year Local Option Tax for Pool Operations and Maintenance

Question - 20 words or less

Shall North Bend impose \$0.56 per \$1,000 of assessed value for pool operations and maintenance for five years beginning 2027-2028?

This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.

Summary - 175 words or less

This measure would authorize a new five-year local option property tax levy to fund operations and maintenance of the North Bend Municipal Pool. A prior levy approved in 2021 under Measure 6-191 expired June 30, 2026. If approved, the City could impose a rate of up to \$0.56 per \$1,000 of assessed value for five fiscal years, beginning July 1, 2027, and ending June 30, 2032. Revenue would be used solely for pool operations, including staffing, utilities, equipment maintenance, and program costs, and not for other City purposes or capital improvements. For property assessed at \$200,000, the annual tax would be approximately \$112. If the measure is not approved, the pool would not have a dedicated property-tax funding source, which could result in reduced hours, reduced programming, or closure. The levy is estimated to raise \$440,300 in 2027-2028, \$470,100 in 2028-2029, \$483,800 in 2029-2030, \$497,800 in 2030-2031, and \$512,200 in 2031-2032, totaling \$2,404,200.

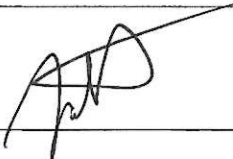
