Yesterday:
Warsaw was settled around 1825 and incorporated in 1855; there were about twenty residences, three general stores, and a combination store/post office in town. The town began to grow as the railroad made the transport of our agricultural products, the backbone of the local economy, feasible. "But the Civil War came and our town was involved in skirmishes. The war did end and growth began again." We are now on the N.C. Civil War Trail list of destinations.

Today:
Warsaw has a rich military history. We take pride in being "The Home of the Oldest Consecutive Veterans Day Celebration in the nation (11/11/21) and the official Veterans Day Parade of North Carolina. We're also proud of the Duplin County Veterans Museum, located in the National Historic District; it is listed as one of the top small museums in N.C. Our National Guard Armory closed a few years ago. It was reopened as a Wellness/Recreation Center benefiting all age groups.

Tomorrow:
Warsaw, located in west-central Duplin Co., is within approximately an hour's drive to major medical, cultural and shopping centers as well as major military bases via NC24 & 50, US 117 and I-40. And C&A Railroad is still here! We hope to build on this ideal location in regards to economic development. But at the end of the day patriotism is the one word that best describes our town.

Warsaw, North Carolina Veteran's Day Parade

The Town of Warsaw received a special recognition in 2016 by being adopted as home to North Carolina's Official Veteran's Day Parade. In its 87th year of the parade, it is the oldest, continuously held Veterans Day Parade in the United States. Warsaw has an enduring sense of patriotism and a commitment to honoring all of our military service personnel, keeping the American spirit alive and well.

With festivities that include helicopter rides, a kids area, craft and food vendors, a car or truck show, a barbecue lunch, a fly over, and most importantly, a chance to thank a veteran. The 2016 parade theme was "Military Law" honoring the men and women dedicated to providing the best legal services to America's service men, women and their families.

While in Warsaw, don't miss visiting the Duplin County Veteran's Museum on Hill Street. Located in the restored L. P. Best House, the museum itself is an outstanding example of Queen Anne/neo-classic style architecture. The house was built in 1894 by its namesake and is the linchpin for the Warsaw Historic District which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places as well as being a locally designated district.

To top off your day, enjoy wine tastings along with lunch or dinner at Warsaw's infamous Country Squire.
